CloudFormation Run Command - Error, AWS doesn't see the profile I'm trying to run the command "aws cloudformation create-stack --stack-name my_stack --template-file my_template.yml" with a profile in the ~/.aws/config file. The

problem is that the ".profile" file is not being followed. My.profile (template) is my_template.yml, has `#!${AWS::Script::GUID}` and I've added it in the ".profile" file like this: `[user@my-stack ~]$ cat ~/.aws/config [default]`
